

Work Opportunity Tax Credit

- Can reduce employer federal tax liability by as much as \$2,400 on new hires
- Requires minimal paperwork
- Employer makes hiring decisions
- No limit on number of new hires
- Encourages employers to hire from eight targeted groups of job seekers
 - Welfare recipients
 - Veterans
 - Ex-felons
 - 18-24 year-old food stamp recipients
 - Vocational Rehabilitation referrals
 - SSI recipients
 - 18-24 year-old EZ/EC residents
 - 16-17 year-old EZ/EC residents
