

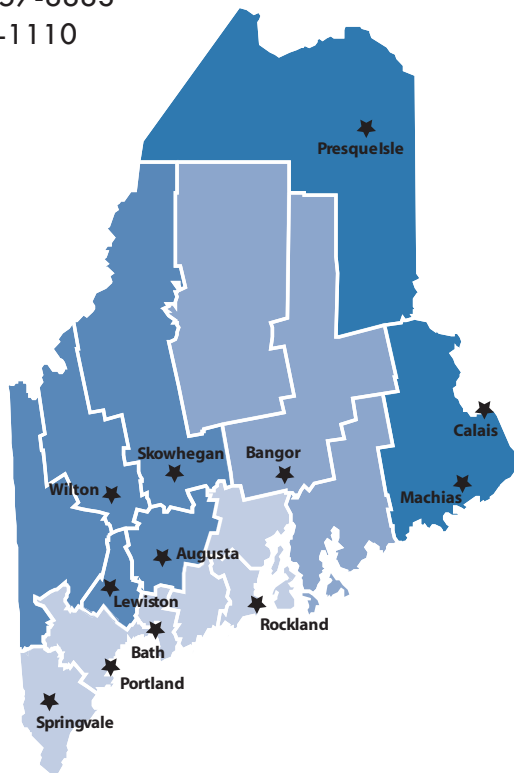

MMHP's mission is to improve the health status of migrant and seasonal farmworkers and their families by providing culturally appropriate care and services. Mobile units and outreach workers travel throughout the blueberry, apple, eggs, Christmas wreath, tree-planting, and broccoli camps offering not only medical and nursing care, but also access to dental services, health education, case management, transportation, and interpretation to MSFWs and their families.

MMHP coordinates a farmworkers' resource center in the Downeast region during the blueberry harvest, providing central access to medical, nursing, and dental services. The resource center also provides farmworkers with access to educational services, social services, a good pantry, and legal aid.
