

2024 CSSP Program Eligibility and Stipend Income Guidelines

Eligibility for CSSP is determined by calculating the sum of the last four weeks of household income at the time of application. Household income must be verified with documentation. We encourage you to apply if you believe your household income is at or below that shown in **Chart # 1: CSSP Program Eligibility Income Guidelines** below. If interested in also receiving a monthly stipend while in training, your household income must be at or below that shown on **Chart # 2: CSSP Stipend Eligibility Income Guidelines**.

Chart #1: CSSP Program Eligibility Income Guidelines

If your household meets the income guidelines in Chart #1, you meet the program eligibility income requirement.

Chart #2: CSSP Stipend Eligibility Income Guidelines

If your household meets the income guidelines in Chart #2, you meet both the program eligibility income requirement and the income requirement to receive a monthly stipend.
