What exactly is a Registered Apprenticeship?

- A workforce training program that provides in-house skill development and on-the-job learning.
- Employees have 2,000 hours of customized training with a mentor and 144 hours of related classroom training per year.

What are the benefits of a Registered Apprenticeship?*

- Reduce turnover, improve loyalty, and retain talented employees – 90% of apprenticeship program finishers stay at their job.
- Employers realize an average return on investment of \$1.47 for every \$1 invested.
- Funding for new and existing sponsors including reimbursement for classroom training costs.
